



LADENFORD DEN, LOUR By FORFAR

Ladenford is situated about 3 miles south east of Forfar in a large wooded area suitable for all activities. There are two camping sites and a Hut. Car Parking is available.

We have put together some information below which should assist with your planning and preparation however if you require further information please email ladenford@girlguidingangus.org.uk.

HUT

The Hut is fully equipped for 22 young people with a separate room for 4 adult leaders. The Main Hall which has an open wood fire and electric heaters is also the activities room, dining room and sleeping area. There 22 slatted "Z" beds with covered mattresses. There are shelves, tables and chairs, and individual lockers. In the entrance hall are cupboards.

KITCHEN

The kitchen contains 2 sinks, 2 cookers, fridge freezer, fridge, freezer, microwave, toaster, dishwasher and plenty worktop space. Complete list of all kitchen equipment can be provided on request. Cleaning materials and dishwasher tablets are not included.

LEADERS' ROOM

This has 4 beds with mattresses, and storage. There is in addition some spare blankets, sleeping bags, pillows, waterproof jackets for those who forget which are stored in the leaders room wardrobe.

PERSONAL HYGIENE

There are 3 WCs, 3 hand basins, plus a shower room which also has a WC and hand basin. There is also a disabled person's shower, WC and hand basin. These are for use when the campsites are occupied. For campers there are also 3 WCs and 3 hand basins with hot water. There are a supply of paper towels available (please use hand towels where appropriate to reduce the impact on the environment) and a starter supply of toilet roll however this should be supplied by your group, and at least a small amount left in each toilet on departure.

ENERGY

Electricity is included in the fees for the immersion heaters, cooking, lighting and heating in the washrooms. There is an open fire in the main hall - the wood for use in the hut is also included in the fees and can be found in the basket at the side of the fire and under the verandah. Please refill the basket before you leave.

You should provide your own fire lighters and matches for the fire. Additional heating for the Main Hall and leaders room is chargeable and will need to be added to your bill at a rate of 20p per unit. There is a sheet by the meter to record the meter readings on arrival and departure. The total amount of electric units used should be recorded on your invoice when making your final payment. (See under **ON DEPARTURE** section).

TELEPHONE

There is a payphone in the entrance hall and the telephone number is 01307 462388 It should be noted that mobile phone reception is not good generally.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT

We have a large selection of sports equipment kept on site for use by all groups, this includes hockey sticks, various bats and balls, goal posts, skipping ropes, cones and markers, hula hoops etc .

CAMP SITE

For campers there is a camp store with a fridge, freezer and electric kettle. There is a wet weather shelter about 20x15 ft open at one side. On the site are two water taps. Wood for cooking fires or campfires can be collected from around the forest. A small amount of dry wood can be used from the hut stores if camping in particularly wet conditions in order to get fire started but additional wood should be collected in addition to the dry wood provided.

Equipment for raised fireplaces plus a BBQ is available - these must not be used on the grass areas. Additional camp equipment is available (ie Patrol tents, mess tents, all cooking equipment, food storage containers, water carriers groundsheets etc) - please see separate sheet of camp equipment

FOOD DELIVERIES

To arrange for food deliveries please use the Ladenford Farm postcode DD8 2LF - and advise the company that it is the campsite that the delivery is for.

EQUIPMENT YOU NEED TO BRING

Personal kit, sleeping bags, blankets, pillows, towels, dish cloths, hand towels, toilet rolls, First Aid kits, cleaning materials, bin liners

CHARGES

Residential (a 10% discount is available for members of girl guiding Angus)

HUT	£ 4.50	per person per night
CAMP SITE	£ 3.50	per person per night
HUT plus CAMP SITE	£ 5.50	per person per night (March - October)
	£ 4.50	per person per night (November-February)

For groups greater than 50 people camping you only pay camp site fees and the hut is free should you wish to book this (depending on availability).

We have split the day into 3 i.e. morning, afternoon or evening

NO JUMPING ON BEDS (broken slats cost £3.00 each)

NO SAPLING OR LIVING TREE TO BE CUT

WOOD SHOULD BE COLLECTED FROM THE FOREST FOR COOKING & CAMPFIRES - The cut wood under the hut is primarily for the hut use and should only be used for outdoor use when it is not possible to collect dry wood

ALTAR FIRES MAY ONLY BE USED IN THE WOODED AREA
